Request For Tender 2017–2018 Snow Plowing Fire Halls

The Argyle Fire Department is seeking a qualified individual or company to submit a proposal for snow removal at the following locations:

- (1) Loring Fire Hall and Ambulance Station. This contract will include clearing snow by shovel from all man doors (3 in total) and Bay doors (4 in total) on both buildings. All doorways are to be sanded and salted after each push.
- (2) Loring Heli-pad, both the main landing area as well as the driveway are to be plowed together and are counted as one push. Plowing only the driveway does not count as a push. Snow around each of the reflective markers must be shoveled by hand to prevent damage prior to clearing using the plow truck.
- (3) Arnstein Fire Hall. Snow to be cleared by shovel from 3 Bay doorways as well as the man door. Please note that there is a new Bay on the westerly rear part of the building. Snow is to be pushed clear of the driveway as well as past the Diesel tank. All doorways are to be sanded and salted after each push.
- (4) Golden Valley Fire Hall. Snow to be cleared by shovel from 3 Bay doorways as well as the man door. Snow is to be pushed well away from the driveways both to the east and to the west of the driveway. All doorways are to be sanded and salted after each push.
- (5) Government Dock in Port Loring. (Dry Hydrant) Snow to be cleared by shovel from the dry hydrant and snow pushed clear of the entire driveway.



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The Contractor shall maintain Comprehensive General Liability Insurance of at least \$2,000,000.00 that protects the contractor from all claims, demands and actions that may be made against the Contractor or employees. Where having employees, Contractor must have WSIB coverage. Please include WSIB clearance certificate with tender submission.

IMPORTANT

Contract is to include "priority plowing" meaning that the Contractor agrees to ensure that the Fire Halls are plowed when the snow level reaches four inches, and the Helicopter Pad is at two inches, at any time day or night.

Price quotes are to be broken down for each location per time plowed. Invoicing needs to reflect the same.

Individual location bids accepted.

Payment shall be made upon presentation of an invoice to the Fire Department, on a mutually acceptable timetable.
