Request for tender for grass cutting 2021 fire halls

The Argyle Fire Department is seeking a qualified individual or company to submit a proposal for grass cutting and trimming at the following locations:

- (1) Loring Fire Hall and Ambulance Station. This contract will include cutting the grass and trimming at both of these locations.
- (2) Loring Heli-pad, the entire pad to be cut and trimming must be done around all pylons. This contract is to be invoiced separate from the other contracts.
- (3) Arnstein Fire Hall. This contract will include cutting of the grass and trimming at this location.
- (4) Golden Valley Fire Hall. This contract will include cutting of the grass and trimming at this location.
- (5) Trash and Treasure. This contract will include cutting of the grass and trimming at this location. Invoicing for this contract is to be separate from the rest.

The Contractor shall maintain Comprehensive General Liability Insurance of at least \$2,000,000.00 that protects the contractor from all claims, demands and actions that may be made against the Contractor or employees. The Contractor must also have on their liability policy the argyle fire department as a “additional insured”. Contractor must have WSIB coverage. Please include WSIB clearance certificate and insurance documents valid and up to date with tender submission. For independent contractors include valid up to date WSIB clearance certificate.
