## LOCAL SERVICES BOARD OF LORING, PORT LORING AND DISTRICT

### BY-LAW #2006-09:

#### Being a by-law to adopt procurement policies.

**Whereas** local services boards are subject to the provisions of (i) *The Northern Services Boards Act*, (the "NBSA"); (ii) the *Municipal Act* ("the Municipal Act"); and (iii) the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("MFIPPA") in respect of the procurement of goods and services; and

**Whereas** the Local Services Board of [Loring, Port Loring, and District] (the "Board") wishes to ensure that its purchases of goods or services are conducted in accordance with the NBSA, the Municipal Act, and MFIPPA;

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

##### **1.0 PROCUREMENT GOALS**

1.1 The goal of the Board's procurement policy is to ensure that when buying goods and services the procurement process used to obtain those goods and services is fair, transparent, efficient and effective.

##### **2.0 BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES AND APPLICABLE LAW**

2.1 The Board has the responsibility for procurement activities and has ultimate authority for all expenditures. No one shall purchase, on behalf of the Board, any goods or services except in accordance with this by-law. All contracts are subject to Board approval.

2.2 Board approval is required to initiate the purchase of goods or services for which funds have not already been designated in the Board's approved estimates.

2.3 When in receipt of funding subject to procurement conditions, such as might be included in a assistance agreement executed between the Board and a government ministry or agency, the Board undertakes to ensure that these funds will be expended using procurement practises that meet the higher of the requirements of this By-law or the assistance agreement.

2.4 The Board may, by by-law, delegate its purchasing responsibility to the Secretary who shall have the authority to purchase goods and/or services in accordance with this by-law. The Secretary shall not pay for any item that has not been authorized by the Board through the Board's approved estimates or a specific by-law.

2.5 Nothing in this By-law is intended to take precedence over the requirements of the NBSA, the Municipal Act or MFIPPA or other applicable laws. The Board acknowledges that information related to the Board's procurement activities is subject to public disclosure pursuant to MFIPPA.

2.6 The Board will keep all information and documentation relating to any procurement under this By-law for auditing purposes for at least seven years following the acquisition of the good or service by purchase order or the satisfactory completion of a procurement contract.

##### **3.0 METHODS OF PROCUREMENT**

3.1 Subject to the exceptions described in Section 4 below, the method of procurement to be used by the Board for any purchase of goods or services is as follows:

PURCHASE VALUE (INCL. ALL TAXES)	PROCUREMENT METHOD	MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
\$0 to \$999.99	Oral quotation	One oral quotation. (LSB to document in minutes details of quote)
\$1,000 to \$4,999.99	Oral quotations	A minimum of 3 oral quotations, where possible and practicable. (LSB to document in minutes details of quotes)
\$5,000 to \$24,999.99	Detailed Written quotations	A minimum of 3 written quotations where possible and practicable.
\$25,000 or more	Formal tendering process	The tendering process outlined in Section 5.0

#### 4.0 EXCEPTIONS

4.1 This By-law does not apply to the acquisition of goods or services:

- (i) where the Board does not give value, directly or indirectly, in exchange for the good or service;
- (ii) such as (i) utilities, including postage, water/sewer charges, hydro, and natural gas; and (ii) licences and permits and similar authorisations, issued by governmental authorities and required to exercise the Board's powers, including, but not limited to vehicle licenses;
- (iii) in an emergency situation requiring the immediate procurement of goods or short-term services, for less than ~~\$10,000.00~~ and a majority of the Board has approved the purchase; or
- (iv) where the good or service is unique to a particular vendor and, it or an equivalent good or service cannot be obtained from another source.

4.2 The Board shall approve all sole source purchasing by by-law. Where the purchase requires an expenditure of ~~\$50,000.00~~ or more, the purchase shall be approved at a meeting of inhabitants.  
150,000.00

4.3 The Board shall keep records of all purchases under this section 4.0 identifying the purchase, the applicable exception and the circumstances of and rational for the purchase.

#### 5.0 THE TENDERING PROCESS

5.1 The tendering process will follow four steps: (i) Preparing the request; (ii) Issuing the request; (iii) Evaluating the bids; and (iv) Contracting.

##### 5.2 *Preparing a Request for Goods or Services*

5.2.1 If there is likely only one way to fulfil the Board's requirements and the Board will compare bids almost entirely on the basis of price, the request shall be referred to as a "request for tenders" or "RFT". If there are likely several ways to fulfil the Board's requirements and the Board will ask bidders to propose their own solutions, and then compare the proposed solutions and other aspects of the bids in addition to price, the request shall be referred to as a "request for proposals" or "RFP". Before an RFP is issued, the Board will either seek legal advice with respect to its contents and, in particular, the project specifications and the evaluation criteria and weights to be used (and any other matters the Board considers appropriate), or document the reasons why it did not seek such legal advice.

5.2.2 An RFT or RFP shall not be issued unless the Board has approved it. An RFT or RFP must contain at least the following information:

- (i) All of the information set out in subsection 5.3.2.
- (ii) A statement that the Board's decision about whether or not a bid was submitted before the deadline shall be final;
- (iii) A statement that unsealed bids will be rejected;

- (iv) A detailed description, including specifications, of the project or goods or services;
- (v) A detailed description or list of the information that a bidder must include in its bid;
- (vi) A statement that non-compliant bids may be rejected by the Board;
- (vii) A description of deliverables for the project, if applicable, including start and end dates;
- (viii) A description of the evaluation criteria to be used by the Board;
- (ix) A statement that the successful bidder must enter into a contract, Board together with appropriate identification of key or unusual terms of the proposed contract, including, for example, a requirement for a performance bond or other security; and
- (x) A statement that the Board reserves the rights (i) to cancel, amend or re-issue the RFT or RFP at any time, (ii) to not enter into a contract with the successful bidder, and (iii) to select more than one bidder to supply some or all of the goods or services.

5.2.3 The Board may seek independent legal, accounting, engineering and other professional advice with respect to the preparation and issuance of an RFT or RFP as it, acting reasonably, considers necessary. In determining whether professional advice is needed, the Board shall consider among other things the financial and technical complexity and value of the procurement, the Board's experience with similar projects and tendering processes, and any unusual requirements or factors relating to the performance of the contract.

### 5.3 *Issuing an RFT or RFP*

5.3.1 An RFT or RFP shall be advertised at least once in at least one newspaper available in the LSB area. The Board shall choose the newspaper on the basis of ensuring the broadest possible publication to potential suppliers. Where no newspapers are available in the LSB area, the RFT or RFP will be sent to at least three (3) suppliers who, in the Board's opinion, are reasonably likely to have the skills, experience and resources necessary to supply the goods and/or services in question.

5.3.2 An advertisement of an RFT or RFP shall contain at least the following information:

- (i) A brief description of the goods and/or services to be purchased;
- (ii) The time, date and location of the on-site meeting, if applicable;
- (iii) The names and contact information of those individuals to whom potential bidders may address technical and other inquiries;
- (iv) The cost to obtain the RFT or RFP, if applicable and where they may be picked up;
- (v) The location where bids must be submitted;
- (vi) The deadline (date and exact time) for submitting bids; and
- (vii) A statement that "The lowest or any bid may not necessarily be accepted."

### 5.4 *Accepting and Evaluating Bids*

5.4.1 Bids will be received by a person designated by the Board. The date and time of receipt will be written on the sealed envelopes and will be initialled by the recipient. Bids that are submitted after the deadline will not be accepted, but will be returned unopened to the bidder. Unsealed bids will not be accepted at any time. Sealed bids that are submitted prior to the submission deadline will remain sealed until the Board meeting at which they will be opened.

5.4.2 Bids will be opened at a Board meeting at which quorum is present. The name of the bidder and bid amount will be announced and recorded for each bid.

5.4.3 Bids will be evaluated using the criteria set out in the RFT or RFP. The Board may authorize an individual or committee to review the bids and make recommendations to the Board. An evaluation summary, including the recommendation for award, shall be presented to the Board for consideration. The Board may accept or reject the recommendation for award, as it sees fit.

5.4.4 The Board shall accept the successful bid by by-law.

## 6.0 PURCHASE ORDER AND CONTRACTS

- 6.1 The award of a contract may be made by way of (i) purchase order, if the value of the contract is under ~~\$5,000.00~~ and the terms and conditions of the purchase order are satisfactory to the Board, or (ii) a written agreement signed by the Board and the vendor. Each of these types of agreement is a "contract" for purposes of this by-law. All contracts shall specify conditions under which either the Board or the vendor may terminate the contract.
- 6.2 The Board shall review and then approve acceptable written agreements by by-law. The Board may obtain independent professional advice as it, acting reasonably, considers necessary. The by-law will identify who may sign the agreement on behalf of the Board.
- 6.3 The Board shall approve any and all changes in a contract that affect price or other terms of the original contract. Where expenditures under a contract are required to be approved by the inhabitants of an LSB either under the NSBA or this By-law, and the Board is considering a change to the contract that will either by itself, or together with prior amendments, result in an increase in expenditures of 15% or more beyond the amount originally approved by the inhabitants, that increase shall be approved by the inhabitants at a meeting held for the purpose, prior to amending the contract.
- 7.0 CONFLICT OF INTEREST**
- 7.1 No person associated with the Board, including members of the Board and its employees, officers and volunteers, shall accept any gifts, entertainment, meals or travel, regardless of value, that might directly or indirectly influence the person's business judgements or decisions, or that might give the appearance of impropriety.
- 7.2 Where a member of the Board has any pecuniary interest, direct or indirect, in the contract, that Board member shall (i) immediately disclose the interest and the general nature thereof to the Board; (ii) shall not take part in the preparation of the RFT or RFP, the evaluation of the bids or award of the contract; and (iii) shall not attempt in any way to influence the award of the contract.
- 7.3 A member of the Board has a pecuniary interest in any contract in which the Board is concerned, if he or she or his or her spouse or same-sex partner is an employee, shareholder, director, senior officer, partner or member of any company, partnership, association or other entity that has a pecuniary interest in the contract.
- 7.4 Where the Board proposes to enter into a contract in which a member of the Board has a pecuniary interest, the approval of the inhabitants of the LSB at a meeting called for the purpose, shall be required prior to executing the contract.
- 8.0 ENACTMENT**
- 8.1 This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

1. In this bylaw
  - A. "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Local Services Board of Loring-Port Loring & District

  - C. "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Local Services Board of Loring - Port Loring & District
2. The rules and regulations contained in this bylaw shall be observed in all proceedings of the Board and shall be the rules and regulations for the order and dispatch of business of the Board, provided that the rules and regulations contained herein may be suspended by a vote of the Board.

BOARD MEETINGS

3. The Board shall conduct sufficient public meetings so that the inhabitants may,
  - (a) participate in discussion of the current and proposed programs of the Board;
  - (b) participate in the preparation of the annual estimates of the Board;
  - (c) participate in a discussion of the annual audit report;
  - (d) participate in the annual election meeting.

4. Meetings of the Board shall be held at the place used by the Board from time to time for such purposes as defined in the Local Services Boards Act. All meetings of the Board shall be open to the public and notice of such meetings shall contain the place, date, time and purpose of the meeting signed by the Secretary, or the person(s) calling the meeting. Copies of this notice shall be posted in at least six conspicuous places in the Board area at least one week in advance of the meeting. The exception to this is the annual election meeting, which shall be posted at least two weeks in advance.
5. As soon after the hour fixed for holding the Board meeting as a quorum is present, the Chairman shall take the Chair and call the meeting to order. A majority of members of the Board constitutes a quorum.
6. If no quorum is present one half hour after the time appointed for a meeting of the Board, the Secretary shall record the names of the Members present and the meeting shall stand adjourned until the next meeting is called.
7. In the absence of the Chairman, or if his office is vacant, or if he refuses to act, the Board may, from among its members, appoint an acting Chairman who, during such absence, vacancy or refusal to act, shall act in the place of the chairman and preside at the meetings of the Board.
8. The concurrent vote of the majority of the whole number of Board Members is necessary to pass any bylaw or approve any measure.
9. All bylaws of the Board shall be under seal.
10. The Chairman may expel or exclude from any meeting any person, including a Board member, for improper conduct at the meeting.

#### THE CONDUCT OF PROCEEDINGS AT A BOARD MEETING

11. It shall be the duty of the Chairman

- C) It must be demonstrated that these costs are covered by a third party (government programs, grants, allowances, etc.) and that any costs not covered by third parties will be accepted by the user group in agreement(s) with the LSB. Users means parties that receive the benefits and agree to pay the costs of providing the service.**
- D) Projects that will benefit the constituents but appear unmanageable for the LSB to undertake shall be offered to individuals or private enterprises to develop and/or manage.**
- E) Any proposal that does not meet the self sufficiency test above shall require a two thirds majority vote at a General Meeting by the constituents of the LSB. A two thirds majority will result in a general levy against all LSB area constituents to fund the project.**
- F) This bylaw may only be rescinded or modified by a three quarters majority vote at a General Meeting of the LSB.**

Statement of Authority

The Loring, Port Loring and District Public Library is established in accordance with the Public Libraries Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990, chapter P.44 and is under the management and control of the Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District which is a corporation operating under the authority of the Act.

The Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District recognizes that the Act sets out procedures for the appointment of members of the Board, the qualifications of members, term of membership, disqualification of members, and vacancies on the Board.

### Purpose of the Board

The Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District shall seek to provide a comprehensive and efficient public library service that reflects the community's unique needs.

The Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District:

- bears legal responsibility for The Loring, Port Loring and District Public Library
- determines and adopts written policies to govern the operation of the Board and library
- understands the library-related needs of the community
- determines the goals and objectives of the library and secures adequate funds to fulfil these goals
- fixes the dates and times for regular meetings of the Board and the mode of calling and conducting them, and ensures that full and correct minutes are kept.
- makes provision for insuring the Board's real and personal property
- takes proper security for the Treasurer
- ensures public representation of the library by the appointment of a public volunteer librarian
- ensures that the library is operated in accordance with the Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter P.44
- approves and submits all reports required or requested by the Municipal Council or the Government of Ontario.

### **Chief Librarian**

The position of Chief Librarian shall be awarded to a public resident representative based on an application or grandfathering criteria and may not be in a position of conflict of interest or have perceived bias while holding this position.

It will be at the discretion of the Board to choose an application process or to grandfather the current Chief position.

If an application process is chosen: this will be done through normal public procedure, requesting applications for the position.

The Chief Librarian will:

- ensure that a monthly report of library projects, activities and upcoming needs is submitted to the LSB at the monthly meeting
- shall train volunteers to the library duties and procedures
- shall ensure all volunteers have completed an application/approval process and meet NNDSB criteria before starting in the library
- shall set scheduling with volunteers
- Is responsible for placing book orders and supply orders upon approval
- Look after the circulation needs of patrons and students
- Maintain the library cataloguing system
- Participate in shelf reading duties for both Library collections
- Managing all duties in regards to donated books
- Oversee display projects
- Oversee annual book fair fundraising
- May delegate daily operations to volunteers where appropriate
- Give due notice of library closure if staffing is not available to the LSB
- May when necessary, take additional operational direction from the LSB as it arises, that may not be listed here

### **Committees of the Board**

The Board may, at the annual meeting and at its discretion appoint the following committees:

A: The Argyle Community Library Committee:

- The Board shall be responsible for establishing the terms of Reference and specific duties of said committee.
- At the first committee meeting a representative shall be chosen by a majority vote of the committee members
- Meetings of the committee shall take place once a month from September to December and January until June.

Meetings may be set by the representative or called by two members of the committee.

- The committee shall be made up of 5 members including:
- 1 (one) representative from the NNDSB by contract, the principal
- the Chief Librarian
- at least 1 (one) member of the LSB

- AND any 2 (two) other representatives

**Purpose of the committee:**

- To discuss, develop and/or implement upon approval by LSB strategies to:
  - publicize the Public Library
  - fundraise for the Public Library
  - research strategies to meet upcoming needs
  - look into available grant funding that is being offered and submit application request to LSB for submission.

**Volunteers:**

- Any resident member of the public may apply to Volunteer in The Public Library
- Applications can be requested from the LSB in writing to the general mailbox or from the Chief Librarian
- There is no honorarium offered for Volunteering in the Public Library
- The Volunteer Application/Information packet contains all of the volunteer guidelines as an addendum to this document.
- Volunteers will receive direction from the Chief Librarian
- Grievances shall be brought to the Chief Librarian and then submitted in writing to the LSB.

**Conflict of Interest/Perceived Bias:**

- All members volunteering in the Public Library are subject to the Conflict of Interest policy and Perceived Bias by-law governing the LSB

**Petty Cash Fund:**

- Shall be maintained and administered by the Chief Librarian
- \$100.00 per draw to a maximum of 600.00 annually
- It may be altered or increased with application to the LSB on a per needs basis within a Board year
- Receipts will be submitted along with the monthly report to the LSB by the Chief Librarian for reimbursement to the petty cash and for records.

**Honorarium:**

- The annual honorarium is set at \$1300.00
- The honorarium will be awarded to the Chief Librarian
- The honorarium will be dispersed on September 15, 2 weeks prior to the closure of the Board year.

**Financial Year:**

- The financial year of the Board shall terminate on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September in each year.

**Signing Officers of the Board:**

- The Board shall appoint at least three signing officers of the Board.
- All cheques or other orders for the payment of money in the name of The Loring Port Loring and District Public Library shall be signed by any two signing officers of the Board.

**Bank Accounts:**

- Bank Accounts required for the business of the Library shall be opened in the Board's name by the Treasurer of the Board in branches of chartered banks, trust companies or credit unions as the board may from time to time determine.
- These accounts are subject to the auditing requirements as set out by the MNDM

**Reimbursement of expenses:**

- The Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District shall at the next scheduled meeting and upon submission of original receipts, reimburse members for Board authorized expenses incurred while carrying out Board approved duties as members of the Library

**Amendment of these procedures:**

- A motion to amend or remove a bylaw of the Loring Port Loring and District Public Library shall require a majority vote of the Local Services Board, providing that public notice be given in the notices and minutes of the Board.
