carried.

## Bylaws, Motions and Notices of Bylaws:

## Bylaw 2016-36

To accept the following as Themed LSB Areas for naming all types of geographic places:

The following areas of A thru Q shall consist of the following:

- A. The area of Pringle Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to 4.
- B. The area of Pringle Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 5 to 9.
- C. The area of Pringle Township consisting of lots 1 to 20 within Concessions 10 to 14.
- D. The area of Mills Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to 4.
- E. The area of Mills Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 5 to 9.
- F. The area of Mills Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 10 to 14.
- G. The area of Hardy Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to 5.
- H. The area of Hardy Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 6 to 10.
- The area of Wilson Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to
   4.
- J. The area of Wilson Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 5 to 9.
- K. The area of Wilson Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 10 to 14.
- L. The area of McConkey Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to 5.
- M. The area of McConkey Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 6 to 10.
- N. The area of Blair Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 1 to 5.
- O. The area of Blair Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 6 to 10.
- P. The area of Blair Township consisting of all lots within Concessions 11 to 15.
- Q. The area of Blair Township consisting of all lots within the Concessions north of Concession 15 to the northern limit of Parry Sound District.

Area "L" shall be designated a "Minerals" area to allow completion of new 911 civic addressing within that area. All others shall be designated themes as decided by Committee and approved by the Board. An SOP shall be issued separately from this bylaw.

Darrell said that the school children could pick the names. Motion by Mike, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve, all in favour, bylaw passed.

#### Bylaw 2016-37

Approve the attached Standard Operating Procedure for Auditor to tender or request for proposal for a Chartered Professional Accountant to audit

the financial statements. This will be added to the critical path. Motion by Julia, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike, all in favour, bylaw passed.

Bylaw 2016-38

Enter into contract with Buchanan Enterprise to rehabilitate the Noganosh Park Way Boat Launch according to the tender and the rate to be paid shall be \$5000.00 plus HST and the LSB will pay \$17,350.01 plus HST for boat ramps. Darrell said that McConkey and Wilson LRB will contribute \$2,000.00 worth of materials and \$1,500.00 donated by Moore's fuel to the LSB. Motion by Steve, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Julia, all in favour, Darrell voted as Mike had a conflict, bylaw passed.

## **Old Business Outstanding:**

# The following old business is outstanding from March 31, 2016

**1. Action Required:** Kerry Booth said the kitchen needs to be upgraded before we get shut down. The Board is looking at a grant for this upgrade. As of September 15<sup>th</sup>, Mike will have a meeting and asked Kerry Booth if he will be able to attend.

## The following old business is outstanding from April 21, 2016

**1. Action Required**: Mike asked Joe Whitmell for a letter outlining what the Argyle Nurses Station use their fundraising dollars for to be given to the committee for consideration. Mike said he has not received anything and for me to write a letter to Joe to provide information to be brought to the committee for discussion. Mike said just to leave this as old business until we receive a letter. Peggy will call Joe to see if he is writing a letter. As of August 18<sup>th</sup> Joe said they are in a transition with the new nurse practitioner and Mike said to check with Joe in a month.

# The following old business is outstanding from August 18, 2016

## Complete from November 19, 2015

End of the month Darrell will meet with the government regarding a centre for seniors. This has been postponed due to the budget preparation. Darrell is currently working with a volunteer to put together the application. Darrell has written 2 letters, but no reply. He will send one more. Darrell said this will be removed and put towards the boat launches.

# Complete from August 18, 2016

Tim Gehrke said that Lisa Lund's office said we would be tax exempt when we purchased the property. I will send a request to Lisa Lund. I contacted Lisa Lund's office and she reviewed the file and confirmed that she did not indicate the property would be exempt from payment of property taxes. I have sent a section 8 to MOF to have both properties exempt from land tax.

1. There was a discussion amongst the community and the Board. Darrell said the Board had an in camera session and they explored all perimeters of ADU, but no breakthroughs. Many questions were brought up including some of the following: How does the Board plan to police this bylaw? They cannot go on people's property to check their buildings. Christopher Ballard said the Fire Department will not act as police. How do you determine what is a dwelling? Rick Curry said the Board is stifling a business in a growing community. A comment that the bylaw was not valid as there was not 3 in favour. Mike said that in the in camera meeting it was discussed that this by-law will not be implemented until they form a committee to investigate further on the best way to tax.
